We have added a new student since our last newsletter, Zander. Zander is 2 ½ and will be joining us every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday for full-days, and occasionally, other days as well. We have had a great time getting to know Zander these past weeks, and are happy that we have added a new friend to our preschool! ☺

The children have really been enjoying circle time. They have learned the routine quite well, and are excited to help in the different activities. Singing the Days of the Week song has really been a huge hit and they are starting to learn the different days of the week. They are quick to pick out the correct day of the week in print when presented with several different choices!

We have continued to study the letters of the alphabet, using our AlphaTale series. The children really love the routines of this program as well, and are having fun taking home their own books and doing the letter-of-the-week activities. I encourage you to extend their learning at home by asking them questions about their letter of the week. What starts with that letter? What sound does that letter make? Practice writing the letter with them throughout the week. Play "I Spy" for the letter of the week when you are out and about, on signs, etc.

This past month we've been talking about the story of Abraham, Sara, and baby Isaac. The children really enjoy the different props used to go along with the readings from the children's bible. They are doing very well saying grace before meals and snacks and using this time to talk about what they are thankful for in their lives. Some of the children even offer to lead grace for us, which is AWESOME! ☺

We introduced our Journals as well, and the children LOVE them! Writing is FUN! Encourage writing (drawing) at home whenever possible!
